## HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM

The high school program is designed for students seeking to graduate high school in Queensland and qualify for university or further study in Australia or abroad.

Students can choose from over 70 schools located throughout Queensland. Each school offers a wide choice of academic, creative and sports programs.

High school in Queensland starts in Year 7 and finishes at the end of Year 12.

Students who complete Years 11 and 12 receive the internationally recognised Queensland Certificate of Education and may be eligible for university study.

## EQI RECOGNISED ENGLISH PATHWAY PROVIDER: SHAFSTON INTERNATIONAL COLLEGE

Education Queensland International (EQI) issues package offers for prospective students wishing to study a **High School Preparation (HSP)** program with Shafston International College (Shafston) prior to their entry into an EQI accredited school. Students can enrol in **Shafston HSP** program and upon graduation will have successfully met the English Language requirements for entry into EQI's High School program.

### HOW TO APPLY

Simply submit a separate Shafston application to [admissions@shafston.edu](mailto:admissions@shafston.edu) and an EQI application in the normal way to confirm your students position at Shafston and EQI. Make sure the student's Shafston HSP program lines up with the EQI High School program commencement date.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All prospective international students need to meet all EQI entry requirements for a package offer to be issued.

The following English language proficiency levels are required to be demonstrated for entry of EQI schools through the EQI and Shafston pathway arrangement.
