YLC Academic - Primary English Preparation (PEP)

7 - 11 Years

PEP program provides a foundational academic framework for younger learners entering the Australian school system. The YLC Academic Cambridge stream is a specialised academic program focused on rigorous preparation for the Cambridge Preliminary English Test (PET) examination. The curriculum is designed to develop higher-level academic English proficiency through intensive study of exam-specific strategies, complex grammatical structures, and advanced vocabulary. Students will master the formal requirements of the PET exam format while enhancing their critical reading, writing, and analytical skills. This pathway provides comprehensive preparation for the official Cambridge PET examination, culminating in the opportunity to earn an internationally recognised certificate that validates advanced academic language proficiency.


