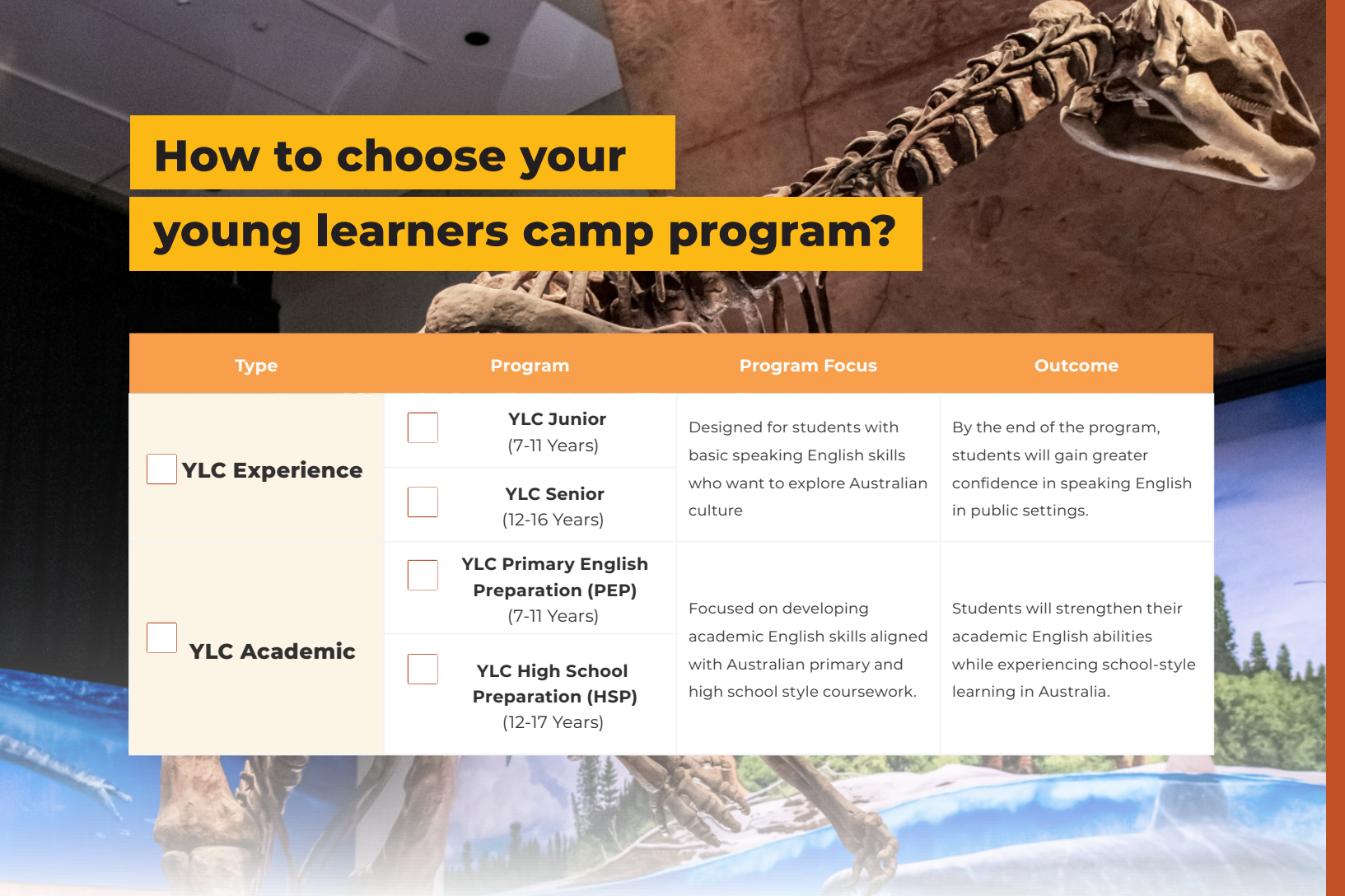


SYDNEY CAMPUS

YLC Academic - Primary English Preparation (PEP)

7 - 11 Years
