University Exploration Program

The University Exploration Program gives students an immersive introduction to Australia's leading higher education institutions through campus visits and one-day or half-day workshops. Students gain insight into a variety of academic disciplines and experience university life firsthand. During the workshops, students engage in hands-on learning, participate in interactive sessions, and explore real university environments that support planning for future study pathways. The program also offers the opportunity to earn a Certificate of Completion from selected courses, providing tangible achievements to strengthen school and university applications.

Hands-on workshops with tailored themes provide engaging, practical insights across a variety of academic fields.




