









Research

University Exploration

This program takes students on in-depth visits to Australia's leading universities, including the University of Sydney, UNSW, UTS, the University of Queensland, Griffith University, and Bond University. Through this program, students will:

- Experience real learning in a university environment and have the opportunity to earn a certificate of completion from university courses.
- Build tangible achievements that will strengthen future university applications and enhance academic development.



Shafston Research

In partnership with leading universities, Shafston has developed a research-based program tailored for junior students. Before departure, students are assigned a themed research project to begin their exploration. Upon arrival in Australia, Shafston provides subject-specific courses and experiential activities related to their chosen theme. The program concludes with a university-led workshop, where students present their findings and complete their research project.

Upon successful completion, students receive both a Shafston Research Certificate and a University Certificate of Completion, adding significant value to future applications for international schools, overseas high schools, and universities.



Oversea Internship Program

Shafston offers students the opportunity to gain valuable overseas internship experience. Each student begins with a 4-week personalised training program, designed to develop Australian and international workplace skills according to their English proficiency and academic background.
